



Light poles with images facing the “moselle” river (Épinal, France)

In the heart of Épinal, a French town famous for its popular illustrations, these “picture poles”, also used for signposting, are facing each other from both sides of the Moselle River. They are exclusively made of aluminum and provide various lighting effects, shedding light on the surrounding squares and roads and illuminating the picture panel mounted on each pole. LED spotlights are

fitted into an aluminum box to light the pictures, which can be replaced with new ones.
