



Industrial heritage site converted into technopole

Lighting design for the zac techn'hom in Belfort accompanying the tertiary conversion of the former Bull factories and highlighting the current Alstom group industrial site. Lighting work on three levels: on the site's showcase façade, the light stages the existing translucent facades and creates a historical scenography of the site (use of archive photos); in the

old centre, the light creates a warm atmosphere and makes the brick colour of the former factories vibrate; finally, the light connects the centre of activity to the rest of Belfort city by providing the site with a nightlife.
